Example – student completing a co-op program (extra semester)

In order to meet the requirements for the Bachelor of Arts degree, a student must complete:

- (a) an arts major (48 points)
- (b) an arts minor (24 points)
- (c) another first-year arts sequence (12 points)
- (d) another 12 points of arts at first, second or third-year level
- (c) a minimum of eight and a maximum of 10 first-year-level units, including three arts sequences from the Faculty of Arts
- (d) a minimum of 36 points at third-year-level including those completed in the major
- (e) a total of 144 points (24 units).

Candidates may complete a second major or a second minor sequence from disciplines offered by the school or from other faculties or schools.

Arts sequence

An Arts sequence is normally a pair of first-level units, from the one discipline, which can form the first part of a major or minor.

Minor

A minor sequence requires the completion of a minimum of 24 points of study and will normally comprise a first-level sequence (12 points) followed by two second-level units (12 points), or two second-level units (12 points) followed by two third-level units (12 points). A minor is normally taken over two years.

Major

A major sequence requires the completion of a minimum of 48 points. Normally a major will include a first-level sequence (12 points) and either two units at second-level (12 points) and four units at third-level (12 points), or three units at second-level (18 points) and three units at third level (18 points). A major is normally taken over three years.

Course Duration
